How to read this guide

Each screen gets a real screenshot with numbered markers. A marker like **1** on the picture matches a numbered note that explains, in plain words, what that part does.

About the names. Inside the app you'll see **Mandarinas CF** (your club) and **"Powered by iLeague"** (the app). This guide calls the app **iLeague**. Everything here is what the app really does — nothing invented.

SECTION 1

Welcome to iLeague Beta

iLeague is a simple companion app for your club. You use it to say whether you can play each week, see your team once it's posted, and follow the season table.



We're in Beta

The app is new and still being polished. Some things are simple on purpose, and more is on the way. Expect a few rough edges.



Reclub is still the main app

Keep using Reclub as you always have. For now, iLeague is a companion you're trying out alongside it — not a replacement.



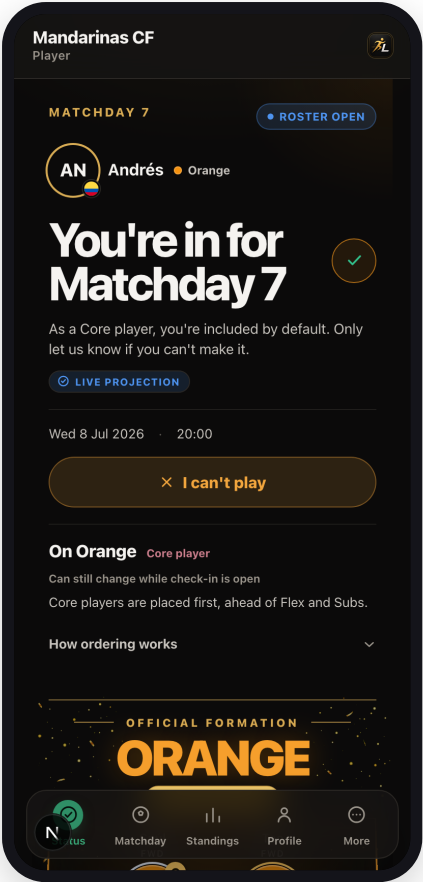
Your feedback matters

If something is confusing or missing, tell your organizer the usual way. There's no feedback button in the app yet — your notes shape what's built next.

Good to know: the words "Beta," "Reclub," and "feedback" don't appear inside the app — they're the friendly context around this trial, not on-screen buttons.

Getting around — the 5 tabs

Along the bottom of the app there are always five tabs. The one you're on lights up. When in doubt, tap **Status** — it's home base.



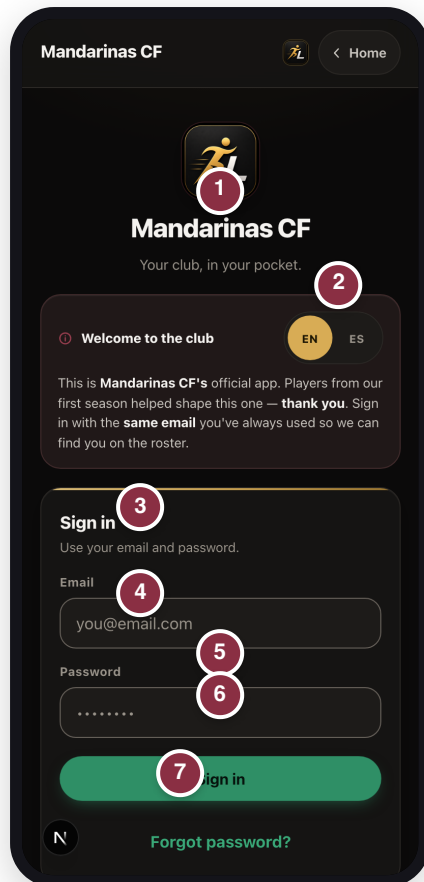
The five tabs sit at the bottom of every screen.

Status	Your personal home. "Am I playing this week?" and your one action.
Matchday	This week's full picture — who's in, the bench, and the teams once posted.
Standings	The season table and your rank.
Profile	Your player card, stats, and account settings.
More	A small menu; today it opens your season Stats .

Two screens live outside the tabs: Queue and Teams. You reach them from the small tiles on your Status screen (Rank · Roster · Waitlist · Teams).

Signing in

iLeague uses your **email and password** only. Sign in with the **same email you've always used** with the club so the app can find you on the roster.



The sign-in screen

- 1 Club name & welcome**
Confirms you're in the right place: "Mandarinas CF — Your club, in your pocket."
- 2 EN / ES language toggle**
Switch the welcome note between English and Spanish.
- 3 Email**
Type the email your organizer has on file for you.
- 4 Password**
Type your password. Always type it yourself — never share it.
- 5 Sign in**
Tap to enter the app.
- 6 Forgot password?**
Don't know it? This emails you a reset link — open it on this same phone.
- 7 Create account**
For making a brand-new account (see next page).

TIPS

- If your organizer gave you a **TEMPORARY PASSWORD**, sign in with it — the app will then ask you to choose your own.
- There is no "magic link." Email + password is the one way in.

Other ways to get set up

Depending on how your organizer added you, your first screen may be one of these.

Create account AVAILABLE NOW

Enter an email you can open on this phone, choose a password (at least 6 characters), and tap **Create account**. Then open the verification email the app sends. After this you still link to your player (below).

Claim your player AVAILABLE NOW

Signed-out: "Sign in to continue"

"Claiming" connects your sign-in to **your name on the club roster**. Sign in, then pick yourself from the list. **Don't pick someone else's name** — if yours isn't there, ask an organizer.

Invite link AVAILABLE NOW

If your organizer sends a personal link, your email is already filled in — you only choose a password, then tap **Create my account**. (Shown in English & Spanish.)

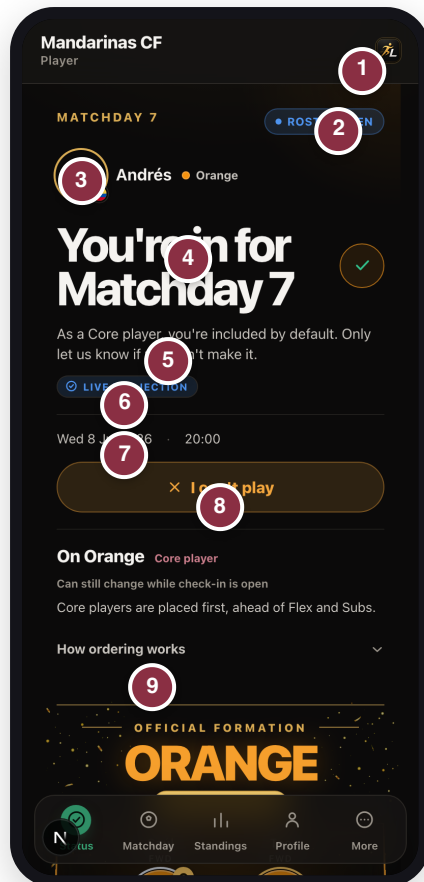
Set / change password AVAILABLE NOW

Signed-out prompt

If you're on a temporary password, the app asks you to **Set your password**. You can also change it later anytime from **Profile** → **Change password**.

The Status screen (home)

What's highlighted: the big "am I playing?" headline, your one action button, and the match details. This screen rewrites itself as the week goes on.



The Status home screen (sample player)

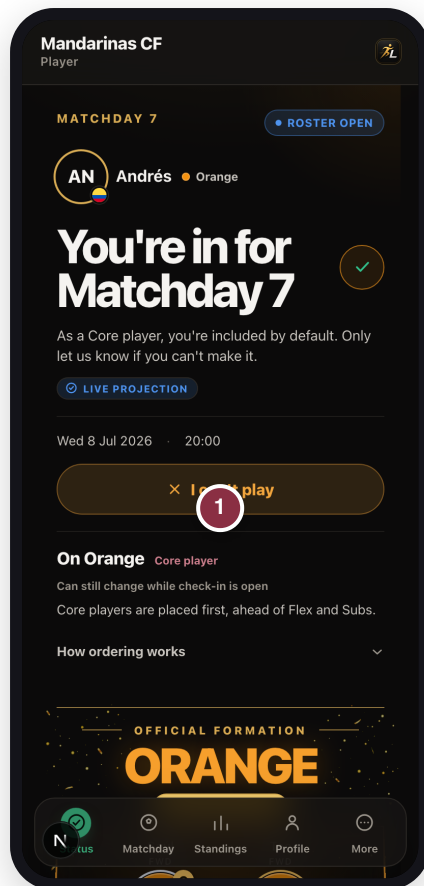
- 1 Account & workspace**
Your account menu — Profile, and Sign out.
- 2 Match status badge**
The week's stage in plain words: "Roster open," "Check-in open," "Roster published," "Closed," and so on.
- 3 You**
Your name and photo. The coloured ring shows your season tier.
- 4 The big answer**
"You're in for Matchday 7," "You're #3 in the queue," or "You're out."
- 5 Plain-language line**
One sentence explaining what that means for you.
- 6 Roster source**
"Live projection" = things can still change; "Roster set" = it's final.
- 7 When**
Date · kick-off time (· venue). This is where the when & where live.
- 8 Your one action**
The single button you tap this week (see Availability, next).
- 9 How ordering works**
Tap to expand a plain explanation of why you're in, waiting, or out.

TIPS

- Scroll down for a season strip and four tiles — **RANK, ROSTER, WAITLIST, TEAMS** — that open Standings, Queue, and Teams.

Availability — checking in

Each week you tell the club whether you can play. Your answer builds the teams and the queue, so keep it up to date.



Your one action button, on the Status screen

It's Yes or No — there's no "Maybe." You're either **available (in)** or **out**. If you're unsure, mark **out** and rejoin once you know.

The one button **1** changes to fit your situation:

- "I can't play" — when you're in and need to step out.
- "Leave Matchday" — when you're waiting and want to drop.
- "Rejoin Matchday" — when you're out and want back in.
- "Join Matchday" — when you haven't joined yet.
- "Drop out of this matchday" — a red button that appears *after teams are posted*.

Your tier sets the tone: **Core** = you're in by default (only act if you can't play). **Flex** = you confirm for a spot. **Sub** = you opt in to fill a spot.

TIPS

- Rejoining after you've marked out sends you to the **BACK OF THE QUEUE** — everyone already waiting keeps their place.
- A confirmation pops up before anything with consequences (stepping out or rejoining).
- After teams are posted, only drop out if you truly can't make it — your organizer has to reshuffle the lineup.

SECTION 6

Matchday

The whole week's picture: who's playing, who's waiting, and the teams once posted. (Your personal date & venue live on the Status screen.)



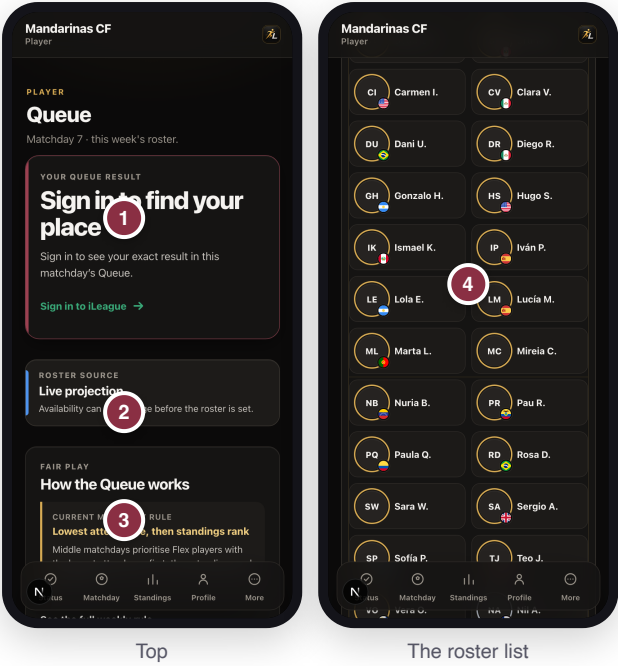
- 1 Title**
"Matchday" with the matchday and season underneath.
- 2 Status chips**
The stage ("Roster open") and whether it can still change ("Live projection").
- 3 What it means**
A plain line, e.g. "Availability can still change until check-in closes."
- 4 Starters**
Everyone selected to play this week. A green "✓ In" shows they're in.
- 5 Player cards**
Photo, initials, and flag. Yours is marked; captains show a "C".
- 6 Bench**
Players waiting, each with a position number (#1, #2, ...).
- 7 Also this week**
Two quiet lines: "Not joined" and "Unavailable."

TIPS

- This screen is **VIEW-ONLY** — you change your availability back on the **STATUS** screen.
- Once teams are posted, a "Teams" section appears here; after the match, a "Result" section links to Match stats and Standings.

Queue

The Queue tells you exactly where you stand this week — selected, on the bench (and what number), not joined, or out — and the fair-play rule behind the order.



- 1 Your Queue result**
Your plain answer: "You're selected," "You're #N on the bench," "You haven't joined," or "You're unavailable." (Signed out, it invites you to sign in.)
- 2 Roster source**
"Live projection" = can still change; "Roster set" / "Published" / "Final" = locked.
- 3 How the Queue works**
This week's fair-play rule. "See the full weekly rule" opens the complete order.
- 4 The lists**
Selected, Bench (numbered), Not joined, and Unavailable. Your own row is highlighted.

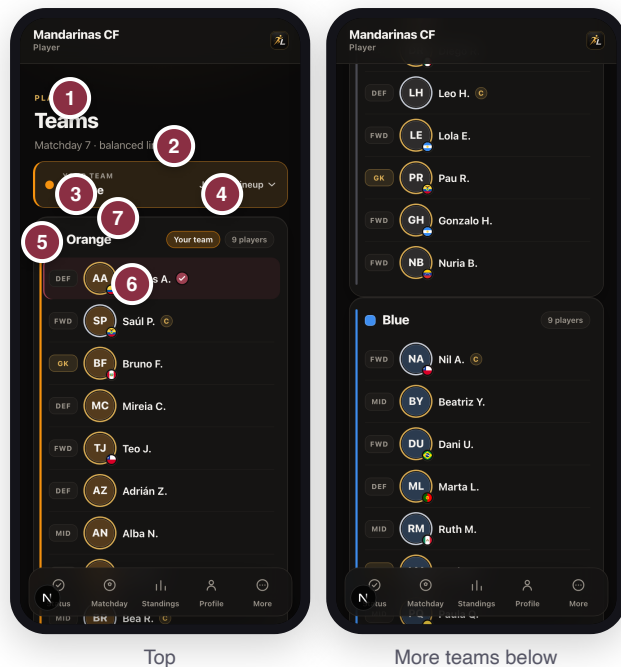
Moving up: before the roster is set, if someone drops out the next bench player moves up automatically. After it's set, the organizer confirms any changes.

TIPS

- The Queue is **VIEW-ONLY** — change your availability on the **STATUS** screen.

Teams

Teams appear **only after the organizer publishes them**. Until then you'll see "Teams aren't published yet."



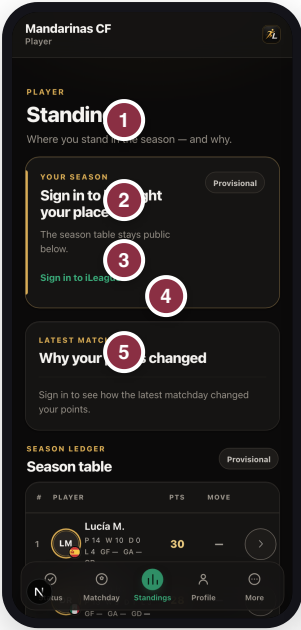
- 1 **Title**
"Teams — balanced lineups" for this matchday.
- 2 **Your team locator**
"Jump to lineup" scrolls straight to your team.
- 3 **Team colour & name**
Each team has a colour dot and a name (Orange, Black, Blue, Lime...).
- 4 **Team chips**
"Your team" marks yours; "9 players" shows the count.
- 5 **Position badge**
GK, DEF, MID, WING, FWD, or ANY. (GK = Goalkeeper.)
- 6 **Captain**
A "C" badge marks the captain.
- 7 **You**
Your own row is highlighted so you spot yourself fast.

TIPS

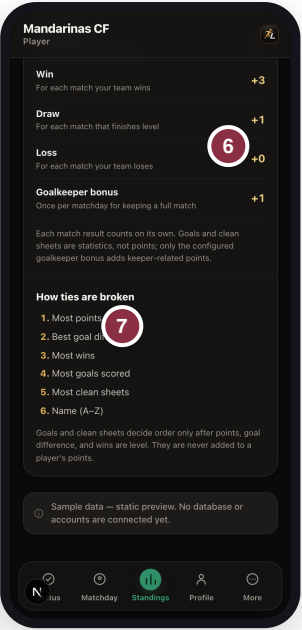
- Everyone sees teams in the **SAME ORDER** — nothing is hidden or reordered per person.
- Want your team drawn on a soccer field? That view is on your **STATUS** screen and inside **MATCHDAY**.

Standings

Where you rank this season — and why your points changed. Standings become **"Official"** after the organizer closes a **matchday**; before that they read "Provisional."



The season table



How points work

- 1

Your season
Your personal rank, points, and record up top (sign in to see it highlighted).
- 2

Why your points changed
A breakdown of your latest matchday.
- 3

Season table
The full league table. A "Provisional/Official" badge shows its state.
- 4

Columns
(rank), Player, Pts (points), Move (up/down since last time).
- 5

Your record
Inside each name: P W D L GF GA GD (see the key below).
- 6

How points are earned
The point values (next page has the full table).
- 7

How ties are broken
The order used when players are level on points.

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How points are earned

Your points come from **showing up** and **how your matches go**. Your organizer can adjust the values, but these are the defaults.

Attendance Once per matchday you play	+1
Win For each match your team wins	+3
Draw For each match that finishes level	+1
Loss For each match your team loses	0
Goalkeeper bonus Once per matchday for keeping a full match	+1

Goals and clean sheets do NOT add points. They're tracked as stats and only used to break ties.

How ties are broken, in order:

1. Most points
2. Best goal difference
3. Most wins
4. Most goals scored
5. Most clean sheets
6. Name (A–Z)

Your Profile

Your player card and account settings.

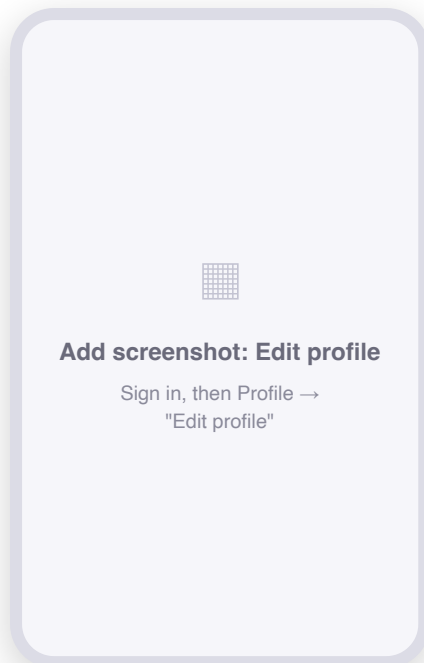


- 1 Edit profile**
Opens the editor (next page). Greyed out until you sign in.
- 2 Your club card**
Name, photo, tier (Core/Flex/Sub), and position.
- 3 Your stats**
Appearances (matchdays played), Rank (season), and Member since.
- 4 Details**
Your self rating and year of birth.
- 5 Achievements**
Any badges you've earned (shows only if you have some).
- 6 Account**
Your phone, Change password, and Sign out.

Your **Rank** here is the same number shown on Status and Standings.

Editing your profile

Tap **Edit profile** to update your card. (This screen needs you to be signed in, so add your own screenshot here.)



What you can change AVAILABLE NOW

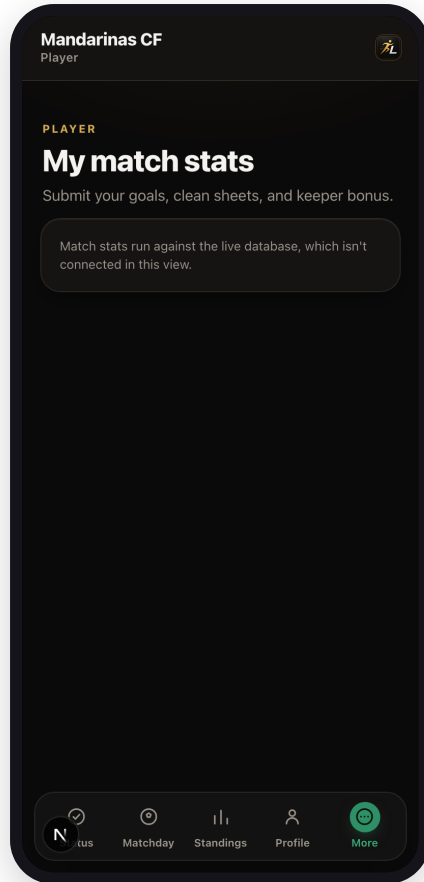
- **Profile photo** — Upload / Replace / Remove (cropped to a square).
- **First name** and **Last name**
- **Nickname / display name** (required — the name people see)
- **Year of birth** and **Self rating (1–5)**
- **Primary** and **Secondary position** (GK / DEF / MID / FWD)
- **Nationality** and **Phone**

Then tap **Save changes** (or **Cancel**).

A **Status** card shows items your organizer controls — Participation agreement, Code of conduct, and account link. You can't edit those here.

Personal match stats

After a match is played and your organizer enters the scores, you submit your own numbers. (This screen needs sign-in and a live match, so add your own screenshot.)



The header you'll see

What you enter AVAILABLE NOW

- Goals
- Clean sheets
- Keeper bonus

Then tap **Submit my stats**. Your submission shows a status: **Awaiting organizer review**, **Approved**, **Rejected**, or **Set by organizer**.

When: only if you were on a team, only after the organizer enters scores, and within a **12-hour window**. After that it locks.

TIPS

- If a teammate's numbers look wrong, tap **FLAG** to ask the organizer to check.
- There is **NO "ASSISTS"** field to submit — just Goals, Clean sheets, and Keeper bonus.

SECTION 13

History

There isn't a separate "History" screen yet **COMING LATER**. For now, your past lives inside screens you already have:

- **Standings** → **"Your season"** — your running record (matchdays, matches, W-D-L, points per game).
- **Standings** → **"Why your points changed"** — a per-matchday breakdown.
- **Profile** → **"Appearances"** — total matchdays played.

SECTION 14

Notifications

✓ What exists today

Nothing pings your phone. The only emails are ones **you** trigger: the sign-up verification link and the "Forgot password?" reset link.

➡ SOON **Planned — not here yet**

Matchday reminders, "teams are posted" or "you moved up the queue" alerts, and any notification settings.

So: open the app to stay up to date. Check **Status** during the week — don't wait for a notification, because there isn't one yet.

Frequently asked questions

Why am I on the bench instead of playing?

Spots are limited and filled by a fair-play order (Core first, then Flex, then Subs). If there was no room, you're placed on the bench in order — check "Your Queue result" on the Queue screen.

Can I change my availability?

Yes — on the Status screen, while check-in is open. Once it's paused or closed, the buttons disappear.

Is there a "Maybe" option?

No. It's in or out only. If unsure, mark out and rejoin later (rejoining puts you at the back of the queue).

Why don't I have a team yet?

Teams appear only after the organizer publishes them. Until then you'll see "Teams not published yet."

How are teams created?

The organizer builds balanced teams from the confirmed roster and publishes them. You see the result once it's official.

When do stats update?

Standings become official after the organizer closes a matchday. Your own stats can be submitted after scores are entered, within a 12-hour window.

What if I cancel after teams are published?

Use "Drop out of this matchday." It's recorded and your organizer is notified, but the lineup may still show your name until they reshuffle it — so only drop out if you truly can't make it.

I signed in but don't see my status. Why?

Your account probably isn't linked to a player yet. Use "Claim your player" or ask your organizer to link you.

Submitting "assists"	NOT AVAILABLE (GOALS, CLEAN SHEETS, KEEPER BONUS)

GLOSSARY

Tier Core (plays by default), Flex (confirms for a spot), Sub (opts in).	Check-in Telling the club whether you can play.
Roster The list of who's playing this week.	Queue / bench The waiting order for open spots.
Published Made official by the organizer (teams become visible).	Clean sheet Your team conceded no goals.
